## Call for Submissions (Fall 2017 Issue)

The University of Ottawa Journal of Medicine (UOJM) is a peer-reviewed journal run and published by graduate and medical students of the Faculty of Medicine. We welcome article submissions in a variety of areas, including: original research, reviews and clinical practice, news and commentaries, case and elective reports, and interviews. **We accept articles in both English and French**, and represent the only bilingual institutional medical journal in Canada. **The UOJM is currently accepting submissions for our upcoming Fall 2017 issue of: Women's Health.**

In recent years, the landscape of women's health has undergone remarkable change, driven by advances in diagnostic procedures, therapeutic interventions, and healthcare provision and policy. Reaching this point has underscored the importance of conducting research and developing practices that improve upon existing resources for women and their healthcare providers. However, these changes have also encouraged discussion from education, medicine, and policy changemakers on how women's health can be better understood and where the healthcare system remains to be improved.

The aim of UOJM Issue 7.2 is to explore discussions of innovative research in women's health and biology. This encompasses a broad range of topics, including, but not limited to, endocrinology, cardiology, oncology, obstetrics and gynecology, psychiatry, neurology, nutrition, sex-based biology, complementary medicine, sports medicine, surgery, medical education, and public policy. The focus of this issue is on women's health in the Canadian healthcare system and policy-making process, however we also invite submissions addressing women's healthcare in a global context.
